



2014 Community Animal Shelter Statistics Overview

Portland, Oregon Metro Region (4 counties in both Oregon and Washington states)

2014 Summary

- **93.1 % Live Release Rate** (compared to 61.5% in 2006)
- 1.57 per 1,000 human population (8.9 in 2006)
- 2,160,565 population (8.8% growth since 2006) in four county metro area
- No euthanasia of healthy or T/R cats or dogs
- 129 T/M euthanasia (40 dogs, 89 cats) - decrease of 97.6% compared to 2006 and 54.3% vs. 2013
- Adjusted Total Euthanasia – 1,913 (637 dogs, 1,276 cats) – decrease of 87.2% compared to 2006 and 25.8% vs. 2013
- Decrease in public intake vs. 2013 – 1,582 (857 less dogs, 725 less cats)
- Adoptions – 20,146 – increase of 4.8% from 2013

2014 Cats

- **91.2% Live Release Rate** (compared to 49.3% in 2006)
- Public Intake 12,071 - decrease of 46% since 2006 (22,353) – 5.7% compared to 2013
- T/M Euthanasia - 89 - decrease of 97.6% since 2006 (3,767) - 55% compared to 2013
- U/U Euthanasia – 1,851 - decrease of 70.7% since 2006 (6,314) - 24% compared to 2013
- Total Adj. Euth. - 1,276 - decrease of 88.8% since 2006 (11,431) – 32.3% compared to 2013

2014 Dogs

- **95.25% Live Release Rate** (compared to 78.4% in 2006)
- Public Intake 9,164- decrease of 38.6% since 2006 (14,930) – 8.5% compared to 2013
- T/M Euthanasia 40 - decrease of 97.4% since 2006 (1,532) – 52.9% compared to 2013
- U/U Euthanasia 1,410 - decrease of 44% since 2006 (2,530) – 3.6% compared to 2013
- Total Adj. Euth. 637 - decrease of 82% since 2006 (3,539) – 7.8% compared to 2013
